CAMP FORMAT

Fullerton Wrestling Camp will develop strong fundamentals for the beginner, intermediate, and advanced wrestler. This camp is designed to increase knowledge in all areas of wrestling including leg attacks, defensive techniques, mat wrestling, leg turns, pinning combinations, and throwing techniques. Camp clinicians are some of America's finest technicians and all experts in their field.

RULES AND SUPERVISION

Campers will be supervised through the entire camp by the professional staff. For your safety, and the safety of the other campers, all campers must abide by the rules and regulations of the camp. Non-compliance to these rules will result in immediate dismissal from the camp without refund.

COACHES

High school coaches are encouraged to attend the Fullerton Wrestling Camp, at no cost if commuting daily. Coaches staying overnight will be charged an at cost fee.

CONFIRMATION

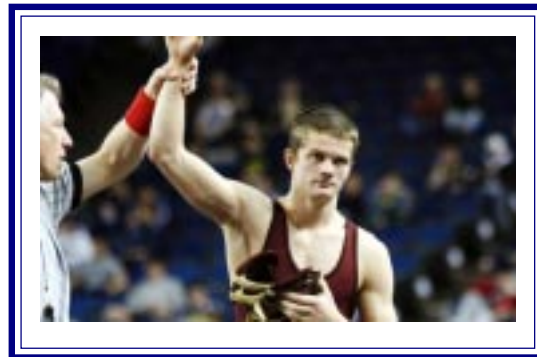

INSURANCE

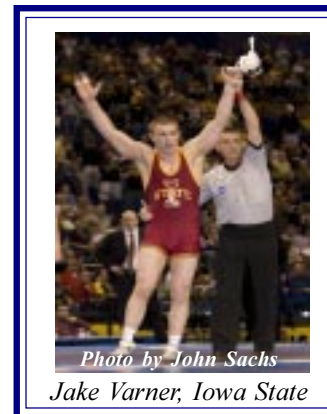

All refunds will be charged a cancellation fee of \$25.00. No refund after July 7th.



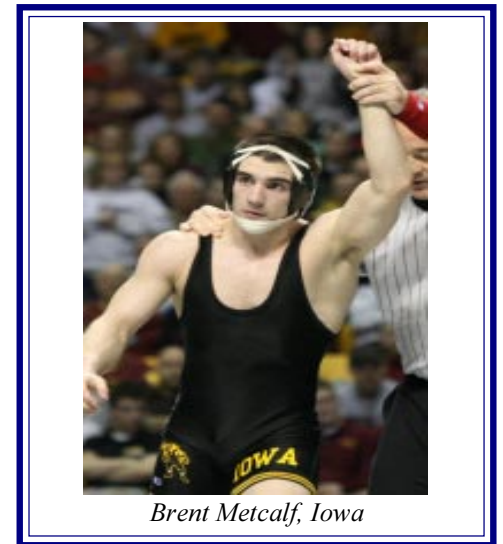
